

# Check in out

### fees

- Please communicate with us, if you need more time to make payments.
  - June payments will not be accepted after May 21st.
  - July payments will not be accepted after June 19th.
- ELC Families
  - Parent fee may vary based on ELC Certificate.
  - Only allowed 3 absences per month.
  - Doctor's note will be required for any absences over 3 days per month.

### ELC Unexcused Absences Update

- ELC students are allowed 1 week of vacation per year;
   advance notice must be provided to program staff.
- Parents are responsible for the private pay rates for days missed beyond 3 days per calendar month, unless a Doctor's Note is provided.
  - Full days are \$25 per day.
- Fees charged for absences must be paid by the 2<sup>nd</sup> business day of the following month. Children will not be allowed to attend camp until fees are paid.
- Excessive absences are grounds for expulsion from Youth Programs.

# Behavior Management

#### Rules

- "Zero Tolerance" for hitting, inappropriate language or gestures, stealing and disrespect shown towards staff.
- Respect adults and each other.

#### Consequences

 Moments of reflection, write-up/loss of activity/field trip, suspension.

#### Rewards

· Pizza parties, ice cream parties, prizes etc...

#### **Bus Safety**

 Students must be seated at all times facing the front of the bus & buckled up.

# Preparing for Camp

#### What to wear

· Sunscreen & Camp Shirt on offsite field trips.

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- K-1st Extra change of clothes.
- If your child does not have a camp T-shirt for off-site trips, he or she will not be able to attend the trip.
- Tennis shoes, t-shirts, and shorts-should be no shorter than middle fingertip length.


#### What to bring

- Extra water & Sunscreen.
- Lunch (If you child is a picky eater).



#### What not to bring

- Money K-3rd Campers do not need any additional money. However, Red Team and Blue Team are allowed to bring money.
- Electronics (i.e. video games, cell phones, etc.) The City is not responsible or anything that is lost, stolen, or broken.
- No stuffed animals, toys, or Pokémon cards.
- Crocs will be treated as water shoes (May not be worn on the facility).



## Field Trips



#### Schedules

- · Field trip times on calendars do not include travel time.
- We leave camp at least 30 minutes before start times listed on calendars.
- Earliest return time from field trips on average is 45 minutes after the scheduled end time listed on calendars.
- Add an additional 30 minutes to departure and return time above for big trips (i.e. Rapids, Calypso Bay, Bedners, and Lion Country Safari).

#### Procedures

 Attendance is taken when children board buses/vans to leave camp, when they arrive at their destination, when they board buses/vans to return to camp, and when they are dropped off at camp.



#### Waivers

- Some field trips require parent waivers.
- · Waivers are emailed to you prior to the trip.
- Please make sure those waivers are signed before the day of the field trip.
- If the waivers are not signed, then the child will not be able to attend the trip.
